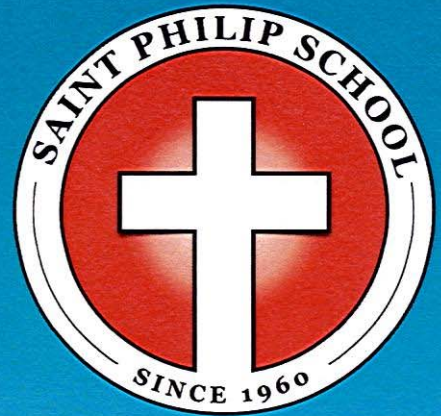

Dear Middle School Parents:

We are looking forward to the 2017–2018 academic year! Below you will find supply needs for the coming year.

Due to the size of some of our textbooks, we are asking that all books be covered with **jumbo sized book socks only**. Some Literature and Algebra books, however, must be covered by a durable paper cover. Please also be aware that projects will be assigned throughout the year which will require poster boards, construction paper, markers, and that regularly used supplies will need to be replenished as we move through the curriculum.

Being prepared for class is an essential part of the learning process. If a student is consistently unprepared (coming to class without supplies), s/he will receive a consequence at the teacher's discretion.

Headphone or earbuds will be necessary this year, for use with Chromebooks. Please be sure that your child has his/her own **soft, zippered supply holder (pencil case) (no hard plastic boxes, please)**, since without one supplies are easily lost. In addition to this, each student will need:
