

Grade 1 Supplies

- 2 Plastic 2 pocket folders (blue, green)
- Durable folder for homework (will need to be replaced as necessary throughout the year)
- ✤ 4 Composition Notebooks (Hardcover, any color)
- 2 Spiral Notebooks (any color)
- 3 Boxes of crayons, 16 or 24 count, one for each trimester (send in all three and I will distribute each trimester)
- 3 Boxes of markers, 8-12 count, one for each trimester (send in all three and I will distribute each trimester)
- 1 Box of colored pencils
- ✤ 6-8 Glue sticks
- ✤ 3 Highlighters
- 2 Pencil boxes (not pouches)
- 1 Pair of scissors
- 1-2 Boxes of pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 3 Pink erasers
- 1 package of Dry erase markers (4 pack, Expo brand preferred)
- 2 sets Flash cards addition and subtraction (1 set is to keep at home for practice)
- 1 Clip board
- For Spanish: 1 folder and 1 notebook
- 1 set of headphones (no earbuds) sent in a labeled gallon size Ziploc bag (We use computers often. This prevents the noise from bothering others if educational programs and interactive educational games are played).
- Each child will also need a backpack (<u>no wheels, please</u>), and a lunch box
- Donations of cleaning wipes, baby wipes, hand sanitizer, and/or Kleenex are appreciated and can be sent in within the first few weeks.

Please label folders, notebooks, and the pencil boxes with your child's name. Name/initials are recommended for other supplies.

***Organizing supplies: Please send in one pencil box packed with 4 pencils, colored pencils, crayons, 1 glue stick, scissors, and 1 eraser. Please send in the other pencil box packed with 1 box of markers, 2 dry erase markers, and a highlighter.

***Place the other crayons, pencils, dry erase markers, markers, highlighters, erasers, flash cards, and glue sticks in labeled gallon size Ziploc bags.

Students will need supplies at home as well for completing homework. Pencils, drawing materials, scissors, glue sticks, and highlighters will be helpful to have at home.
