<b>Science:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 single subject spiral notebook</li><li>• 2-pocket folder</li></ul>	<b>Social Studies:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 single subject spiral notebook</li><li>• ½” binder</li><li>• 200 - 3X5” Index cards - lined - <u>white</u> (no boxes for the index cards)</li></ul>
<b>Health:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ½” binder with lined paper in it</li><li>• 2-pocket folder</li></ul>	<b>Music:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ½” binder, with dividers with tabs and lined paper in it</li></ul>
<b>Religion:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 ” binder, with 3 dividers</li><li>• 1 package of looseleaf</li></ul>	<b>Spanish:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 single subject spiral notebook</li><li>• 2-pocket folder</li></ul>
<b>Technology:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Headphones (earbuds are fine, Air Pods are <u>not</u>)</li></ul>
